### Applications open

This programme is delivered over 6 days (5 classroom teaching days and a graduation day), over a 5 month period. You will learn about the theory of quality improvement: planning projects, engaging and motivating others, measurement, PDSA cycles and sustaining your improvements, and apply these to a project within your work area. The teaching days will be interactive and will include both presentations from our faculty as well as group activities and discussion.

We ask for a commitment from you and your manager in terms of the time involved completing the course. In return, you will have access to support and materials to help you complete your project. You will also be allocated a mentor for the duration of your course and we expect you to meet with your Mentor a minimum of 3 times throughout the programme.
